Торіс	Rogue Creamery is a cheese manufacturing company with a production facility adjacent to sensitive ecosystems.
Summary of Issue	The company has its dairy facility along the Rogue River that contains wetlands and riparian areas. This ecosystem area is protected by the Oregon Department of State Lands.
	Wetlands are considered sensitive ecosystems that provide the world with natural storm barriers, environmental cleansers, and food and water resources for many forms of life.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Between 1%-5% of the company's production occurs in a facility adjacent to the Rogue River wetlands area.
Impact on Stakeholders	Having facilities near protected/sensitive ecosystems can potentially impact the flora, fauna and quality of the ecosystem (e.g. noise & light pollution from the facilities, spills, air / soil / water pollution owing to the company's operations).
	The primary potential risk as a result of Rogue Creamery operations include microbial load from organic fertilizing runoff.
Implemented Management Practices	Rogue Creamery's main area of operation has an average of 300 feet away from wetlands and the river. The company maintains 6.6 acres by the river for wetland habitat to avoid any potential runoff into the river. The minimum requirements are an average of 75 feet from the river.
	The company's cheese products are Certified Organic by Oregon Tilth to the USDA Organic Regulations, which assures that the process meets the organic standards and does not use pesticides that could alter the ecosystem.
	The company complies with all local regulations and has specific procedures for employees and suppliers operating in sensitive ecosystems.
