Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

- Intentional misrepresentation of practices, policies, and/or claimed outcomes during the company's certification process

Issue Date	August 2024
Topic	Voluntary Bankruptcy Protection Proceeding
Summary of Issue	Avon Products, Inc. (API) is a U.Sbased non-operational holding company of the Avon beauty brand which was acquired by the Brazil-based Natura & Co in 2020. On August 12, 2024, Avon Products Inc. announced they had initiated voluntary Chapter 11 proceedings in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware in order to address its debt and legacy talc lawsuits related to Avon's discontinued US operations.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Only Avon Products Inc. and certain of its US subsidiaries are part of the bankruptcy proceedings. Its non-US operations are not part of these proceedings. The bankruptcy is to address all of Avon Product Inc.'s debt and legacy talc liabilities. Natura & Co has committed up to \$43 million in debtor-in-possession financing that, subject to Court approval, will provide sufficient liquidity to fund Avon's obligations during the bankruptcy process.
Impact on Stakeholders	Avon Products Inc. does not have any business operations in the US, and only its creditors are impacted by these proceedings. The Chapter 11 filing is not expected to impact Avon's operations outside of the United States, which are not part of the proceedings. Companies currently in bankruptcy (or currently under administration or filed for insolvency) are ineligible for B Corp certification. As of the date of this disclosure, neither Avon Products Inc. nor its US subsidiaries are B Corp Certified entities of Natura &Co.
Management Practices	Avon Products Inc. and its US subsidiaries are currently operating independently, even while being financially supported by Natura & Co. Natura & Co has agreed to support Avon's activities throughout the Chapter 11 proceedings via the granting of a debtor-in-possession (DIP) loan and has entered into an agreement to purchase equity interests in Avon's non-US operations through a court-supervised auction process for \$125 million.
