| Summary of Issue | Lonsdale is a branding and design company that has had clients operating in the Offensive Weapons/Firearms and Gambling industries over the last 5 years. Services to these clients included the design of the company's new logotype on their brand platform, as well as the interior design of hospitality spaces of a casino, allowing casino users to have a better perception and control of time dedicated to gaming. Services sold by the company can be sold to both companies in controversial as well as non-controversial industries. The company has decided to discontinue working with clients in the Offensive Weapons/Firearms industry since 2023. |
| Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected) | In FY2023, the company has 0% of revenue from clients operating in the Offensive Weapons/Firearms Industry. Lonsdale had a one-off engagement from a client in this industry in 2022-2021. |
| | Clients operating in the Gambling industry represented 0.01% of the company's FY2023 revenue and engagement with this client was a one-off engagement in 2022 representing 1% of the company's revenue. Lonsdale is not currently working with this industry. |
| Impact on Stakeholders | Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can indirectly increase the harmful impact to stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry. |
| | B Lab has flagged the involvement of companies with clients in controversial industries as a material issue and new standards will be created to address possible risks related to this matter. |
| Implemented Management Practices | The company has a policy that clients operating in controversial industries should not represent more than 10% of their total revenue, which they are currently meeting. This rule is taken into consideration in the company's executive committee decisions |



and commercial meetings. Londsdale holds a commercial meeting every week attended by all managers in charge of clients and prospecting. They review their commercial actions and business activities and during these meetings when the issue of a new prospect with potentially questionable activities arises, they discuss how to proceed, either gather more details to be able to make a decision, decide not to participate in the tender or determine that their activities are acceptable. As part of their due diligence process, the company considers the client's defined mission. Londsdale have agreed that their own new business development efforts must exclusively target clients who do not belong to controversial industries, as part of this commitment, clients operating in the Gambling and Defense, Offensive Weapons, firearms and munitions industries will not become subjects of ongoing commercial development once the current missions have been completed. We have established a rule that our activity with controversial companies should never exceed 10%. However, we currently remain well below this threshold, as we manage to maintain
