Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Operations and suppliers located in Conflict Zones

Topic	Company operates and has suppliers located in Myanmar which is classified as a conflict zone.
Summary of Issue	Golden Sunland is a Singapore company engaged in full value chain rice production in Myanmar.
	The company's presence in Myanmar is related to agriculture business, contract farming, seed production, and processing of paddy to rice for the Myanmar market and some exported to Singapore.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the fiscal year end of 2023, Golden Sunland's revenues attributable to Myanmar is 66%, and the percentage of expenses related to Myanmar is 90%.
Impact on Stakeholders	Business activities located in conflict zones are considered high-risk as they are more likely to cause or contribute to the conflict and/or sociopolitical instability.
	Countries classified as conflict zones are more likely to have a weak rule-of-law or a corrupt judicial system, which could undermine the effectiveness of operational grievance mechanisms for these businesses and their suppliers. In addition, the safety of the company's workers and other potential human rights violations are at risk.
Implemented Management Practices	Golden Sunland is committed to conducting all business activities following international laws and regulations, prioritizing the safety and well-being of all its employees. The company has a Risk Assessment Policy for Conflict Zones. This policy outlines the areas of risk such as if there is security for field workers and if there are any risks associated with field workers traveling. The policy ensures that the zone supervisors and lead farmers must cooperate with the regional authorized organization to inspect and measure the severity of the conflict when an emergency has been declared. The regional authorized organization is established by the government and consists of the village and ward administration, along with the appointed administrator responsible for overseeing the affected zones.
	Golden Sunland's management would need to determine if the



operations can continue, or should be paused based on the severity of the conflict reported by the zone supervisor and lead farmer of the conflict affected zone. The company would resume operations in the conflict zone affected areas when the circumstances are stabilized.

In terms of its supplier practices, Golden Sunland has a formal Supplier Code of Conduct which outlines mandatory practices that the company would require of its suppliers. The policy contains guidelines on the following issues;

- Human rights work
- Forced labor
- Child labor
- Freedom of association and collective bargaining
- Anti-discrimination and fair treatment
- Wages and benefits
- Health and safety
- Product quality and safety
- Environment
- Business integrity
