Issue Date	Between 2021 and 2025
Topic	Litigations related to consumer protection and labor issues
Summary of Issue	<p>During the period stated above, Norda Stelo Inc reported being a defendant in 44 litigation cases (29 settled and 15 pending) filed by its clients for alleged design errors and technical omissions in projects by its engineers</p> <p>Additionally, Norda Stelo Inc reported being a defendant in a labor collective claim case initiated by a former employee of the company who was diagnosed with noise-induced sensorineural hearing loss in the left ear and sensorineural hearing loss in the right ear.</p>
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	<p>Of the 29 settled cases, the overall amount paid in settlements represents around 6.72% of the company's last fiscal year revenue.</p> <p>While the projected amount for the pending cases represents about 6.63% of the company's last fiscal year's revenue</p> <p>For the labor topic, there was no direct financial settlement paid to the plaintiff by the defendant because of the application of the CNESST compensation procedures through which the collective allocation of funds into a common fund was used to cover the costs of occupational hearing loss incurred by the former employee.</p>
Impact on Stakeholders	<p>The primary impacted stakeholders for design errors and technical omissions are the clients and consumers</p> <p>The primary stakeholder impacted by the labor issue is the former employee</p>
Resolution	<p>29 cases of consumer protection have been settled with payment by the company, while the remaining 15 are still pending a final resolution.</p> <p>Regarding the labor topic, the Tribunal concluded that the hearing loss is partially work-related, resulting from excessive noise exposure during the course of employment with Norda</p>

	Stelo Inc. The indirect financial settlement was conducted through the application of the aforementioned CNESST compensation procedures.
Management Practices	<p>The identified discrepancies related to the design and technical errors were corrected by the company</p> <p>At the time of the incident, hearing protection measures at the company primarily consisted of the use of individual protective equipment. Since then, legislative requirements have evolved to prioritize noise reduction at the source within workplaces. To address this, all employees receive training upon hiring:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The risks associated with noise exposure.• Applicable legal requirements concerning the company's clients and contractors• Proper use of hearing protection equipment.• Earmuffs are offered to all employees along with their construction helmets at the time of hiring.• Additionally, the company's Health and Safety Committee is attentive to this issue and is currently leading a project to ensure the effectiveness of hearing protectors using the 3M EarFit testing device.

Topic	Negative PR
Summary of Issue	On October 25, 2024, a former executive of Roche Itée, now Norda Stelo Inc, had a 14-month sentence due to participation in a bid-rigging scheme for Québec City contracts between 2006 and 2010. The former executive pleaded guilty before the Court of Quebec and admitted conspiring to divide up Québec City municipal infrastructure contracts among seven other engineering-consulting firms while he was vice-president of infrastructure for the company.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The company had to pay 750,000 CAD under a settlement agreement
Impact on Stakeholders	Rigging bids on public contracts artificially increases costs and enriches individuals and companies involved. The primary impact of these actions is reputational damage on the company, and a financial and social impact on the community where the rigging of bids happened.
Resolution	The case has been settled through the company's payment.
Management Practices	<p>Since its restructuring and name change in 2015, Norda Stelo has implemented an ethical and transparent governance framework. The company is now independent and employee-owned, with a mission focused on the common good and sustainable development.</p> <p>The cases involved individuals and practices that are no longer in place and do not reflect the company's current culture.</p>

Summary of Issue	<p>Norda Stelo Inc. has clients in the following industries: Fossil Fuels, Mining</p> <p>The types of services/products offered to these clients include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">tailored services throughout the project lifecycle, from initial exploration and feasibility studies, detailed engineering, asset durability, and operation optimization
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the last fiscal year, between 3-5% of the company's annual revenue was from clients in Fossil Fuels, and approximately 5% from Mining.
Impact on Stakeholders	<p>Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can directly or indirectly increase the harmful impact on stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry.</p> <p>Companies offering certain types of services and products to controversial clients are required to have at a minimum a grievance/complaints mechanism and a whistleblower protection policy.</p>
Implemented Management Practices	<p>B Lab has been able to verify that the company has the necessary mechanisms in place to manage the risks related to their business relationships with clients in controversial and ineligible industries, in line with B Lab's requirements (see link below). This includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">A mechanism for internal and external stakeholders to raise grievances;A policy that is shared with individuals who raise a grievance, containing information related to the grounds for accepting a grievance and how their grievance will be dealt with, as well as related timelines.

Management Comments	<p>"We believe that, despite the existence of potential negative impacts, Norda Stelo stricly focus on generating positive impact that its services and advisory activities can generate for stakeholders. By supporting its clients in improving their practices, managing risks, environmental and safety risks, and reducing negative impacts, the company can actively contribute to a transition toward more responsible models within controversial industries."</p>
