Disclosure Materials

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

B Lab's Public Complaints Process

Any party may submit a complaint about a current B Corp through B Lab's Public Complaint Process. Grounds for complaint include:

- Intentional misrepresentation of practices, policies, and/or claimed outcomes during the company's certification process
- Breaches of the B Corp Community's core values as expressed in our Declaration of Interdependence

Issue Date	2024
Topic	Litigation, Arbitration, and/or Penalties related to Mislabelling of Products
Summary of Issue	The company faces a litigation brought on by competitors regarding an advertisement campaign of 2020 for false advertisement. Appeal is in progress. The company faced two litigations for similar issues. One verdict in favour of the company, and the other one was against the company.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The case that was settled cost the company less than 1% of its total revenue for the last fiscal year.
	The value for each pending case is estimated to be less than 1% of the company's total revenue for the last fiscal year.
Impact on Stakeholders	Competitors and Consumers
Management Practices	Some names have already been changed in the new packaging. The company is also working with an expert regulatory consultant who is guiding the company in the revision of the labelling and in the determination of the commercial names of the products, among other aspects. The company believes that there is no clear regulatory framework for the category and the names of some plant-based products
