

## DISCLOSURE MATERIALS

Certified B Corporations must complete a Disclosure Questionnaire to identify potentially sensitive issues related to the company (e.g. historical fines, sanctions, material litigation, or sensitive industry practices).

This component does not affect the company's score on the B Impact Assessment. If the company answers affirmatively to any items in the Disclosure Questionnaire and B Lab deems them to be material, the company must:

- 1) Be transparent about the disclosure issues identified on the company's public B Impact Report
- 2) Describe how the company has addressed this issue.
- 3) Demonstrate that management systems are in place to avoid similar issues from arising in the future.

In all cases, the Standards Advisory council reserves the right to refuse certification if the company is ultimately deemed not to uphold the spirit of the community.

In addition to the voluntary indication of sensitive issues in the Disclosure Questionnaire, companies pursuing Certification also are subject to background checks by B Lab staff. Background checks include a review of public records, news sources, and search engines for company names, brands, executives/founders, and other relevant topics.

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

<b>SUMMARY OF ISSUE</b>	Two Le Slip Francais employees attended a party where the hostess was in blackface. One Le Slip Francais employee was wearing a gorilla mask, while the second Le Slip Francais employee was laughing. The hostess and the party are not affiliated with Le Slip Francais. There was negative news and social media coverage of the incident. The two employees are no longer employed at Le Slip Francais.

<b>IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS</b>	<p>"The use of blackface has the potential to negatively impact stakeholders (e.g., employees, communities), particularly Black stakeholders.</p> <p>Blackface occurs when people darken their skin (e.g., with shoe polish, greasepaint, burnt cork) and paint on enlarged lips and other exaggerated features. The practice is steeped in centuries of racism. It allows a society to routinely and historically imagine the Black community as not fully human and serves to rationalize violence and segregation (source)."</p>
<b>RESOLUTION IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES</b>	<p>The two employees are no longer employed at Le Slip Francais.</p> <p>"The company has implemented an Inclusion and Diversity Roadmap. This roadmap incorporates the following components:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Based on third-party expertise (Mixity)</li> <li>- Measurability and Improvement: Outlines initiatives to improve Mixity score to 70% by 2023 (vs. 45% currently). This includes using a third-party hiring company to promote diversity in new hires.</li> <li>- Transparency: Progress on Roadmap is shared with the company during weekly meetings.</li> <li>- Accountability: Day-to-day lead is an HR Manager. The management team (including the CEO and CFO) were involved in creating the Roadmap and continue to support HR Manager.</li> </ul> <p>Also, following the incident, the company invited SoS Racism to conduct workshops with employees.
