SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In 2019, between 30 and 35% of the company's revenue came from clients in the oil & gas, mining, or non-renewable power generation sectors.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDER(S)	While these sectors are frequently subject to stakeholder concerns related to their environmental impact, Fluitec's products and services are designed to reduce the Greenhouse Gas emissions of its clients and thus deliver a positive environmental impact.

IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	As part of the restructure, the company split some business units into independent companies allowing those business units to retain Conservatorio as a client and allow for flexibility of working with other clients in the area. The units that were not converted to independent companies were given a minimum of two-weeks notice with a full package severance pay to all affected parties and depending on their individual status were offered: (I) Personalized consultancy and access to network for future job placements, (ii) Hired as independent consultants to provide services for the company as a freelancer. It is important to note that Conservatorio continues to work with these newly formed companies as part of their indirect value chain.
