SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a textile manufacturing facility, Onsmooth Thai operates in an industry operates in an industry that is energy and carbon emissions intensive.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	100% of the company's revenue is derived from the manufacturing of textile products
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	The textile industry is a major contributor to global carbon emissions.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	The company's energy consumption and emissions are derived from sewing machines, heaters, ovens, forklift battery chargers, and from utilities e.g. lighting, air conditioner, air compressor and office equipment use.  Onsmooth Thai has calculated its energy intensity as 2.37kWH/unit and determined that 41.98% of its carbon footrpint is derived from electrical use. The energy used is fossil fuel (natural gas).  Although the company has not conducted an assessment of how it compares with others in their industry in terms of energy consumption, it has a target of reducing its FY2021-2022 consumption by 20%. Onsmooth Thai aims to achieve this target by switching exclusively to LED lighting (149 units), installing a heater timer switch as well as a solar roof top project.
MANAGEMENT COMMENTS	Onsmooth Thai has adopted verified Higg FEM to monitor energy and emissions. The company has quantifiable reduction targets and purchases certified carbon credits.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a textile manufacturing company, OnSmooth Thai operates in an industry that is water intensive.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the previous fiscal year, 100% of Onsmooth Thai's revenue was earned from the sale of textiles.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	As a water intensive industry, textile manufacturing poses risks such as water stress or depletion of local water sources if water use is not appropriately managed. Onsmooth Thai uses groundwater sources and does not operate in a water stressed region in Thailand.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	The company has calculated its water intensity as 3.59 litres/unit. Although the company has not conducted an assessment of how it compares to others in the industry in relation to water consumption, it has set a target of reducing water use by 5% between 2021 and 2022, through the installation of low-flow taps.

ISSUE DATE	February 8, 2021.
TOPIC	Failed wastewater quality test on an occasion in 2021.
SUMMARY OF ISSUE	The Wastewater Quality Test report from the Ministry of Industry indicated oil and grease water levels above Thai requirements. The cause of the discharge was found to be both unknown and unintentional.  The wastewater had the presence of low levels of oil and grease, suspended solids, and bad odor, discharging outside of the company's factory. There was no significant chemical spill.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The company was issued a fine of THB 6,000 (under \$US200) related to wastewater pollution. No individuals were affected.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	There was no employee or community impact reported as a result of the wastewater discharged.
RESOLUTION	The company paid the fine.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	To reduce the risk of further incidents, Onsmooth Thai hired an external supplier to remove wastewater for treatment, then installed a biological wastewater treatment system on-site. The company monitors wastewater quality monthly at the outlet to ensure compliance with all standards.
