Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Litigation, Arbitration, Penalties, and/or Regulatory Complaints

Technord reported having two material litigation filed against the company related to the following issue: Labor. Those cases had repercussions in the last five years.

Legal disputes, arbitration, penalties and regulatory complaints can adversely affect external stakeholders by disrupting customer service, causing uncertainty and financial negative impacts for suppliers and employees, and diminishing investor confidence. Additionally, these issues may damage the company's reputation, and result in broader economic and regulatory repercussions. Certified B Corps must make their involvement in Litigation, Arbitration, Penalties, and Regulatory complaints transparent under their B Corp Profile.

Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Other - Clients in Controversial Industries

Topic	Clients in Controversial Industries
Summary of Issue	Technord is an engineering firm specialising in the integration of industrial projects, offering services in automation and electricity, support in innovation by implementing IOT, optimisation (Data Science and modelling) as well as real-time industrial computing.
	The company has had clients in the Pharmaceutical and Zoos, Aquariums & Animal parks industries which are deemed controversial by B Lab. Technord provided various services to the clients which includes Power Management, Process Control, Manufacturing Execution System (MES) and Data Sciences.
	The services provided to the clients can be sold to other clients in different industries, including other both non-controversial and controversial industries.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the fiscal year end of 2023, the company had generated 16.15% of revenue through clients in the pharmaceutical industry and 0.48% of revenue through clients in the zoos, aquariums & animal industry.
Impact on Stakeholders	Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can indirectly increase the harmful impact to stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry.
	B Lab has flagged the involvement of companies with clients in controversial industries as a material issue and new standards will be created to address possible risks related to this matter.
Implemented Management Practices	Technord does not intend to work with industries associated with weapon/arms and tabaco.
	The company has a risk committee that evaluates the risk related to potential clients/project that are from other controversial industries. The team would screen to ensure the



prospective client business is in alignment with Technord's values.

The projects carried out by Technord are typically associated with having a positive output on their clients' impact. For example, they work on projects related to decarbonation, waste management and blue-collars ergonomy.

Topic	Tax Penalties
Summary of Issue	In 2023 Technord Belgium have been subject of a tax audit by the Belgium administration related to 2021 & 2022 fiscal years, conducting to a tax adjustment.
	The auditor challenged transfer costs and argued it was not reflecting the market realities.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The company was required to pay additional taxes and penalties at the total value of EUR 264,000 in 2023, which corresponded to less than 1% of the company's annual revenue.
Impact on Stakeholders	In addition to the many different aspects of value that businesses provide to society, businesses have an obligation to contribute their share of taxes. As businesses exist within the context of society; their proper role is to serve society. Moreover, healthy businesses can only exist over the long term in a healthy society. A healthy society depends upon public expenditures made possible by taxes. These public expenditures benefit business in both direct and indirect ways.
Resolution	The case was closed against the company.
Implemented Management Practices	To prevent any future cases, a cabinet expert in transfer pricing has been mandated in 2023 to study Technord, transfer pricing rules and bring advice at the end of 2024 related to:
	First application of the recommendations in 2024 statutory account, and adjustment link to 2023
	Fiscal watch to anticipate any future change in fiscal legislation.
