

DISCLOSURE MATERIALS

Certified B Corporations must complete a Disclosure Questionnaire to identify potentially sensitive issues related to the company (e.g. historical fines, sanctions, material litigation, or sensitive industry practices).

This component does not affect the company's score on the B Impact Assessment. If the company answers affirmatively to any items in the Disclosure Questionnaire and B Lab deems them to be material, the company must:

- 1) Be transparent about the disclosure issues identified on the company's public B Impact Report
- 2) Describe how the company has addressed this issue.
- 3) Demonstrate that management systems are in place to avoid similar issues from arising in the future.

In all cases, the Standards Advisory council reserves the right to refuse certification if the company is ultimately deemed not to uphold the spirit of the community.

In addition to the voluntary indication of sensitive issues in the Disclosure Questionnaire, companies pursuing Certification also are subject to background checks by B Lab staff. Background checks include a review of public records, news sources, and search engines for company names, brands, executives/founders, and other relevant topics.

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

Other - Clients in Controversial Industries
Company has clients in the alcohol industry
Compass Creative Studio Pty Ltd provides PR and digital marketing support for a brewery, specifically for an equity raise in the company. Also, the company managed the paid social media spend for a winery. The aim of the campaign was to encourage awareness of the independent and boutique winery's credentials in the environmental and impact space. The overall alcohol industry is considered controversial by B Lab due to its social risks related to human health and well-being. Both projects practiced responsible drinking at all times and only proactively promoted the operations to people over the legal drinking age in their markets; these messages were incorporated at all times in all communications.
In the last 5 years, the company earned less than 1% of its revenue from companies in the alcohol industry.
Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can indirectly increase the harmful impact to stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry.
B Lab has flagged the involvement of companies with clients in controversial industries as a material issue and new standards will be created to address possible risks related to this matter.
 At Compass, to qualify its potential partners the company uses a Partner Impact Form to ensure it is supporting ethical, environmentally friendly, impact-led brands. This form aims to ensure that Compass considers a partner's suitability on a values and ethics basis and consistently reviews more than just the monetary value of that engagement, In regards to the two alcohol industry campaigns, there were no elements to the campaign that proactively encouraged anyone to purchase or drink alcohol.
