Issue Date	2018
Topic	Penalties related to Insufficient Professional Conduct
Summary of Issue	Litigation was brought against the company by the patient, claiming insufficient disclosure upon referral when addressing the patient's issues. It was decided by the Maryland Department of Health- Board of Physicians the payment of a fee by the company.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The penalty was a total of USD 100,000, which represented between 1 and 2% of the company's revenue at the time.
Impact on Stakeholders	The patient of the company was affected.
Resolution	Penalty of Professional Reprimand and fee of \$50,000 per doctor, 2 in total), resulting in a total of \$100,000. The case was closed afterwards.

Topic	Sexual Harassment
Summary of Issue	In the last 5 years, the company faced 3 cases of sexual harassment.  2 cases were settled with payment paid by the company and closed. 1 case was closed and the charge dismissed due to unfounded allegations.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	For the cases that were settled, they resulted in a payment of 72.500 USD by the company, which corresponded to less than 1% of company's revenue at the time

Resolution	For 3 cases of sexual harassment, 2 were settled and 1 was dismissed due to unfounded allegations.
