Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

Any party may submit a complaint about a current B Corp through B Lab's Public Complaint Process. Grounds for complaint include:

- Intentional misrepresentation of practices, policies, and/or claimed outcomes during the company's certification process
- 2) Breaches of the B Corp Community's core values as expressed in our Declaration of Interdependence

Disclosure Questionnaire Statement

Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Others - Disclosure Industries

Topic	Clients in Controversial Industries
Summary of Issue	The Blakeney Group is a communications and public affairs agency that has served clients in the Gambling and Water Utilities industries over the last 5 years. Services to the client in the Gambling industry included engaging with key political stakeholders and policymakers to support reform of regulation and legislation of the UK gambling sector. Work for the client in the Water Utilities industry involved helping the company communicate the steps they are taking in addressing the critical issues of water shortage and the involvement of relevant stakeholders. The services offered to clients in these industries can be offered to both clients in controversial as well as non-controversial industries.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Revenue from the client in the Gambling sector was 2% in FY2023. At the beginning of 2024, Blakeney made a commitment to reduce revenue from clients operating in this industry to below 1% within 12 months. Clients from the Water Utility industry represented 12% of the company's FY2023 revenue.
Impact on Stakeholders	Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can indirectly increase the harmful impact to stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry. B Lab has flagged the involvement of companies with clients in controversial industries as a material issue and new standards will be created to address possible risks related to this matter.
Implemented Management Practices	Blakeney states they do not work with any company that is actively seeking to have a negative impact on its people, its community or the wider environment. Ahead of working with any potential client partner Blakeney assesses whether the company and the scope of work conflict with this position. In addition, as part of each client brief, they carry out research into the company to understand the nature of their work, the



impact of their operations and the scope of work being requested. This includes a web and social audit, a media coverage assessment and can also include discussing with external trusted stakeholder's views on the company and its operations. In the cases where a client's industry is considered controversial, the company has an open discussion with their employees to seek their view before any decision is made. Blakeney also has a non-executive advisory Board that meets every quarter where Blakeney's leadership team seek their view. New clients decisions are overseen by Tote's partners, founders and CEO, who monitors to ensure the work they do aligns with their business purpose and values. In addition, the Tote team members have created and live the values and foster an open feedback culture for any team member to raise concerns if work conflicts with their values. **Management Comments** The contract with the Water Company has ended (effective 31st March) and has not been renewed. Therefore Blakeney currently receives no revenue from the Water Industry. In 2024 it is expected that revenue from clients in the Water Utilities sector will fall to around 3%.
