Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Litigation

Issue Date	Issues related to the period between 1 April 2018 to 31 March 2023
Topic	Litigation cases related to the services provided by the firm, and discriminatory labor issues.
Summary of Issue	Between 2018 to 2023 the firm has had a total of 24 litigation cases related to the services provided by the firm and either an error, or alleged negligence in the delivery of their service, or a disability discrimination claim from a former partner diagnosed with mental health problems. The discriminatory labor issue case concluded in 2018 in which the plaintiff won and the firm was found liable, it came to the Tribunal in 2020 and judgment was issued in April 2021 and is considered closed.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	According to the firm, the total amount of all the cases (litigation and labor issues) resulted in a combined settlement value of less than 1% of the firm's total revenue.
Impact on Stakeholders	The cases impacted the claimants by causing financial or legal implications, and lack of resources and protections concerning mental health of employees.
Resolution	Each case has been settled financially with the claimant apart from one which is currently ongoing.
Management Practices	The firm constantly assesses and evolves its approach to risk and works hard to minimize the number of claims arising each year. This has included an increased risk and compliance team of five people and robust protocols around peer review and quality control. This area remains a key focus for the firm.
	In terms of the discrimination labor issue: since the incident and court case the company has, in conjunction with Mental Health England, offered Mental Health First Aider courses to employees. The firm offers support through its Employee Assistance program or by referral to Validium (a mental health specialist), and can offer specific instructions to specialists when the firm is concerned about an individual's mental wellbeing. The firm offers an opportunity to download the



	Headspace App (supporting mental wellbeing) at a subsidized cost and the firm runs various wellbeing workshops. The firm offers additional resources through its Intranet.
Management Comments	All professional service advisory firms are occasionally subject to claims. These typically relate to alleged mistakes in advice provided. The firm has been subject to 23 such claims and 1 discriminatory labor issue in the period between 1 April 2018 to 31 March 2023. Claims are dealt with and compensation, where appropriate, paid under the terms of the firm's professional indemnity insurance.
