Topic	Litigation cases related to labors
Summary of Issue	The company has 15 litigation cases involving a variety of labor-related claims, including occupational illness, job misclassification and function deviation, workplace accidents, salary differences (including unpaid commissions and off-the-record payments), additional pay for hazardous or unhealthy conditions, unpaid overtime, wrongful termination, and claims for material damages and penalties.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The estimated value for all of the cases settled through payment was less than 1% of the company's total revenue in the last fiscal year.
Impact on Stakeholder(s)	Potential financial and safety impact to the employees.
Resolution	Most cases were resolved through mutual agreement (settlements) and subsequently archived. Others were closed due to claim withdrawal or court rulings (either upheld or dismissed). One case was suspended due to a formalized payment arrangement.
Implemented Management Practices	The company has taken a comprehensive set of actions, including ergonomic reviews, regular health exams, salary alignment through job function reviews, defensive driving training, and rigorous control of working hours. It has also improved workplace safety, environmental monitoring, internal procedures, and legal oversight. Payment practices and termination calculations were reviewed and corrected where necessary. New measures include updated safety and risk mitigation protocols, revised job structures, improved time-tracking systems, clearer contracts and training for commercial teams, and strengthened financial and labor compliance controls.
