TOPIC	Water Intensive Industries
SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a contract manufacturer of cosmetics, toiletries and general products, Orean Personal Care Ltd operates in an industry that is water intensive.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	100% of company's revenue came from contract manufacturing service. In 2021, company's water consumption was 33,035 cubic meters. 20% of this water went directly into the products they produce. The remaining was used in the process of manufacturing for heating and cooling, for the toilets, and for the cleaning of the facilities. Water is provided by Yorkshire Water and the company is not located in a water stressed area.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	As a water intensive industry, it poses risks such as water stress or depletion of local water sources if water use is not appropriately managed.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	During the production, the mixing is filled into Intermediate Bulk Container (IBC) and then into bottles. Water is normally used at this stage to clean the IBC. Now, the factory uses Pallecon IBC liners which remove the cleaning step of the IBC, as the liner is disposable. Company's facilities are also equipped with automated tap and low flush toilets.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	The company is a contract manufacturer of cosmetics, toiletries and general products. The company is using natural gas, electricity from the grid and solar panel generated.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	100% of company's revenue came from contract manufacturing service. In 2021, the company has an electricity consumption of about 560 MWh (of which 41% came from renewable sources) and a gas consumption of 887 MWh.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	Energy intensive industries can contribute to climate change and have negative impacts such as air pollution and the associated health impacts on air quality.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	 The factory is equipped with LED lighting and occupancy sensors. Boilers are serviced every year, and employees are encouraged to carpool and are offered the bike-to-work scheme. New roller shutter doors have been installed in the factory to reduce heating energy. The company ensures that all wagons turn off their engines when in the yard or are standing waiting to enter the yard. Cars drive in and park up and are usually out of the car park in under 30 seconds. Engines are not left running. The factory is equipped with solar panels and the energy is monitored every month and audited to PAS 2060 standards. They are currently certified carbon-neutral. The company's third-party transporter is certified to FORS GOLD standards.
MANAGEMENT COMMENTS	The company has not set any target for 2022, as they are looking to be part of the science-based target initiatives. But the company has had a 12% reduction in emissions from 2020 to 2021 based on company turnover.
