SUMMARY OF ISSUE	Black Isle Brewing Co Ltd is a brewery and earns a material amount of revenue from the manufacturing and sale of alcohol.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the previous fiscal year, around 75% of Black Isle Brewing Co Ltd's revenue was earned from the sale of alcohol
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	Alcohol may have a negative impact on the health and well-being of individuals and their communities.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	 The company is fully compliant across all jurisdictions regarding the manufacturing and sale of alcohol products; The company also advocates for responsible drinking on their product labels and detail the number of units of alcohol contained within each product. The company encourages their customers to enjoy their products for its quality, and does not encourage excessive drinking. In addition, the bar staff is trained and fully supported regarding their right to refuse service to any customer who they deem to be disruptive to other customers or staff through the excessive consumption of alcohol.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a brewery, Black Isle Brewing Co Ltd operates in an industry that is water intensive.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Around 75% of Black Isle Brewing Co Ltd's revenue is from the sale of products from brewing process.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	As a water intensive industry, brewing processes pose risks such as water stress or depletion of local water sources if water use is not appropriately managed. Black Isle Brewing Co Ltd uses water from their private on site borehole for their brewery and from public Scottish supplier for the bar and hostel. None of their operations are located in water stressed regions.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	 In order to minimize water requirement, Black Isle Brewing Co Ltd has installed their own borehole on site and used their wastewater as fertilizer to their brewery farm; Black Isle Brewing Co Ltd is producing beer at a 5:1 water/beer ratio, which is more efficient than the 7:1 average; The company's employees are trained to use minimal water throughout the process. In addition, company is planning the installation of a new brewery with a water treatment system, they aim to reduce their water/beer ratio to 3.5:1.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As a brewery, Black Isle Brewing Co Ltd uses energy and fossil fuels in their manufacturing process and therefore operates in an energy and emissions intensive industry.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Around 75% of Black Isle Brewing Co Ltd's revenue is from the sale of products manufactured in the brewery.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	As a energy intensive industry, brewing processes pose risks such as energy waste or overuse if this resource is not appropriately managed.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	 The company opts to use an electricity supplier that provides 100% renewable energy; Organic raw materials are preferred in order to reduce emissions in the upstream; Employees are encouraged to commute by bicycle and receive training in order to minimize energy consumption on-site; The company has a tree planting project (over 7000 was planted so far) and signed the SME Climate Commitment; Company tracks their emissions and energy consumption through carbon footprint assessment and compare themselves with other breweries in order to make improvement plans for their facilities.
