Score Aggregation Methodology & Brand List

BONDUELLE FRANCE (BELL & FRESH), SPAIN, PORTUGAL, DENMARK, BELGIUM, NETHERLANDS and CHAMPILAND 2024

As the B Corporation Certification is a company-level certification, the assessment of a Parent Company is required to include its subsidiaries in which it owns >50% of the shares and has a controlling interest. Depending on the operations of the certifying company, Parent Companies may roll up their subsidiaries into a single assessment or assess separately.

Regardless of whether a Certified Parent Company's subsidiaries are assessed together or separately, only distinct subsidiaries that B Lab has determined independently meet the performance requirement for certification (i.e. score of 80+ points) are eligible to use the Certified B Corporation logo and refer to themselves as Certified B Corporations.

Aggregated Scoring Methodology

BONDUELLE FRANCE (BELL & FRESH), SPAIN, PORTUGAL, DENMARK, BELGIUM, NETHERLANDS and CHAMPILAND and its subsidiaries were required to be assessed in the B Impact Assessment and undergo a review by B Lab staff. The entities were divided into 5 assessments, and the overall score was calculated using a weighted average based on headcount.

The assessments are as follows:

- 1. BELL France
- 2. Bonduelle Fresh France & Spain
- 3. Bonduelle Denmark, Belgium, Netherlands
- 4. Bonduelle Spain & Portugal
- 5. Champiland

Based on the weighted average, **BONDUELLE FRANCE (BELL & FRESH)**, **SPAIN**, **PORTUGAL**, **DENMARK**, **BELGIUM**, **NETHERLANDS and CHAMPILAND** scored an overall 93.7* out of 200 total available points. The minimum verified score required for B Corp Certification is 80.
