Summary of Issue	Deokhwafood is involved in fishing, fisheries and aquaculture industry as a seafood product manufacturer. The company that is based in South Korea produces 100% of its products in-house, with suppliers providing only raw, auxiliary, and packaging materials.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	100% of the company's revenue consists of products from the fishing, fisheries, and aquaculture industry.
Impact on Stakeholder(s)	The fishing industry may have negative environmental impacts on their affected marine ecosystems, e.g., overfishing, loss of biodiversity, pollution. Furthermore, the fishing industry is at risk of human rights violations in their supply chains.
Implemented Management Practices	The company produces 100% of its seafood products in-house, allowing full traceability to the original source.
	All of the company's products are certified by the following;
	MSC (Marine Stewardship Council) Summary of products: All wild-caught seafood products from sustainable fisheries are certified under MSC, ensuring traceability and adherence to sustainable fishing practices. Percentage of products covered: 100% of wild-caught seafood products.
	 2. HACCP (Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points) Summary of products: All processed seafood and aquaculture products are HACCP certified, guaranteeing food safety through systematic hazard analysis and control measures. Percentage of products covered: 100% of processed and aquaculture products.
	Products certified under MSC and HACCP have clearly documented supply chains from raw materials to finished products, enabling 100% of sales to be traced back to their origin. For external suppliers of packaging materials and



auxiliary ingredients, key suppliers are verified through test reports and certificates of origin, and compliance with environmental and social criteria is assessed.

The MSC certification ensures well-managed fishing practices to minimize overfishing and environmental impact, and maintain healthy fish stocks.

All supplier evaluation is conducted based on the HACCP audit criteria to determine whether transactions can proceed. The evaluation includes items such as greenhouse gas emissions, waste management, water quality certificates, and records of administrative sanctions, ensuring that suppliers meet environmental and social standards which includes greenhouse gas emissions, waste management, water quality tests, and administrative records, with corrective actions taken as needed.

In accordance with the HACCP requirements, employee management and training are conducted through business ethics training, disclosure of employment regulations, onboarding training materials, and support for human rights organizations. These measures help prevent risks related to forced labor and human rights, and corrective actions are promptly taken if any issues arise, ensuring ongoing risk management.

The company manages key suppliers by reviewing relevant documents such as test reports and certificates of origin, and conducts regular evaluations based on the HACCP certification system. In addition, the company checks the list of employers with wage arrears, and although not currently used in production, the company is promoting the purchase of Fairtrade-certified raw materials. Some products, such as office coffee beans, already utilize Fairtrade-certified materials, helping to minimize risks within the company's supply chain.
