Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Tax Reduction Through Corporate Structure

Topic	Fund structure and fund advisory company in the Cayman Islands
Summary of Issue	Maison Capital is a private equity fund manager based in Hong Kong that has an offshore fund structure registered in the Cayman Islands. Due to regulations in Hong Kong at the time of the fund's registration, the company also established an entity in the Cayman Islands to act as the fund advisor. This entity has no staff, and subcontracts its advisory services to the company's Hong Kong entity. In 2022, B Lab released new risk standards applicable to Financial Services in Tax Havens and Wealth Planning Structures Companies. Maison Capital was already certified at the time the standards were published and because of that, the company is given one recertification cycle to meet the new standards applicable to them. By next recertification, it will be evaluated how the company is meeting the new requirements.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Approximately 40% of Maison Capital's annual revenue comes from advisory fees associated with its Cayman operations.
Impact on Stakeholders	Companies in the wealth planning structures industry play a significant role in global wealth holding and creation, alongside other financial service companies, especially those who operate in jurisdictions that are known as tax havens for corporations or individuals. Given the important nature of their services, their operations and business models also have associated risks. While a company's specific risk will vary, the most material potential risks related to the industry can be categorized as: concealment of beneficial ownership and wealth sources; money laundering and corruption; and tax evasion and avoidance.
Implemented Management Practices	Maison Capital's advisory company in the Caymans retains a small percentage (~5%) of its annual revenues to pay for expenses associated with this entity (e.g. local legal advice,
