Summary of Issue	Mediatyche has clients in the following industries: Gambling.
	The types of services offered to these clients include: - Communications sustainability consultancy
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the last fiscal year, 10% of the company's annual revenue was from a client in the Gambling industry.
Impact on Stakeholder(s)	Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can directly or indirectly increase the harmful impact to stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry.
	Companies offering certain types of services and products to controversial clients are required to have at minimum a grievance/complaints mechanism and a whistleblower protection policy.
Implemented Management Practices	Mediatyche has the following mechanisms in place to manage the risks associated to serving clients in the controversial industries:
	Grievance/complaints mechanism. This is accessible to the public through a Whistleblower Form available on the company's website. Once a grievance is submitted, the company acknowledges its receipt within 7 business days and conducts an initial review to assess the validity and seriousness of the complaint to determine whether further investigation is required. Within 90 business days, the company's Ethics Committee will provide a resolution.
	Whistleblower Protection Policy. The Policy includes the company's commitment to protecting whistleblowers from retaliation. To ensure the protection of whistleblowers, the company has implemented the following mechanisms:



	 Anonymous reporting system: Possibility to make reports anonymously; Transparent information: Clear communication about who will be involved in the process; Informed consent: Asking for consent before sharing information with additional parties; Confidentiality of outcome: Protection of information regarding the outcome of the process; Risk assessment: Analysis of potential risks to the whistleblower before starting the investigation; Collaboration with independent experts: Engagement of third parties to assess risks for vulnerable whistleblowers;
	Mediatyche has zero tolerance for any form of retaliation against whistleblowers. In the event of proven retaliation: Immediate disciplinary action will be taken against those responsible. Legal action may be taken if applicable. The whistleblower will receive support and protection Measures will be implemented to mitigate any negative consequences suffered by the whistleblower.
