

DISCLOSURE MATERIALS

- 1) Be transparent about the disclosure issues identified on the company's public B Impact Report
- 2) Describe how the company has addressed this issue.
- 3) Demonstrate that management systems are in place to avoid similar issues from arising in the future.

In all cases, the Standards Advisory council reserves the right to refuse certification if the company is ultimately deemed not to uphold the spirit of the community.

In addition to the voluntary indication of sensitive issues in the Disclosure Questionnaire, companies pursuing Certification also are subject to background checks by B Lab staff. Background checks include a review of public records, news sources, and search engines for company names, brands, executives/founders, and other relevant topics.

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	As an agricultural (and partially wild fruits manufacturer) company, Isla Natura Exportadora Ltda operates in an industry in which biodiversity impact is a material environmental issue. healthy food manufacturing company
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Approximately 95% of supplier expenses comes directly from growers/harvesters.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	Agriculture poses a risk to the flora and fauna of local ecosystems as well as the potential degradation of cultivated land.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	80% of the company's sales are healthy food products made with wild fruits provided by local small harvesters/growers and harvested by hand in order to avoid any ecosystem alteration, and with no use of fertilizers or pesticides. Over 60% of the wild fruits are processed in the company's facility and have the USDA Organic Certificate. Approximately 25% of the company's raw material is local honey from a small beekeeper written in the Export Honey Beekeepers Registry (RAMEX in Chile) that guarantees a beekeeper work free of chemicals, pesticides and contaminants. The pollination of its bees occurs only in the native forests of Chiloe Island (Chile), so it is very positive for the environment and the care and propagation of native species and wild areas. Approximately 5% of raw materials are from monoculture production (almonds, chia, amaranth seeds). The company screens for small local suppliers to know better their harvesting practices. Although the company does not have any specific targets related to preserving or conserving biodiversity in its supply chain, it prefers to use wild fruits as raw material for its products, prioritizing hand harvesting process and water conservation.
OTHER MANAGEMENT COMMENTS	100% of Isla Natura's sales are of healthy, delicious food options that are gluten free and do not contain any processed sugars. Isla Natura is dedicated to "production in origin" of raw materials and specifically the wild berries and honey that comprise the vast majority (over 95%) of the company's ingredients. In this way Isla Natura can better insure the quality of the raw materials, better ensure the harvesting/cultivating methods are sustainable and also work towards having a local benefit from the production of these materials (through jobs and education) and in so doing, promote the community's health, economic well-being and environmental awareness.
