

DISCLOSURE MATERIALS

Certified B Corporations must complete a Disclosure Questionnaire to identify potentially sensitive issues related to the company (e.g. historical fines, sanctions, material litigation, or sensitive industry practices).

This component does not affect the company's score on the B Impact Assessment. If the company answers affirmatively to any items in the Disclosure Questionnaire and B Lab deems them to be material, the company must:

- 1) Be transparent about the disclosure issues identified on the company's public B Impact Report
- 2) Describe how the company has addressed this issue.
- 3) Demonstrate that management systems are in place to avoid similar issues from arising in the future.

In all cases, the Standards Advisory council reserves the right to refuse certification if the company is ultimately deemed not to uphold the spirit of the community.

Background checks include a review of public records, news sources, and search engines for company names, brands, executives/founders, and other relevant topics.

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	MRO MaryRuth LLC has had 1 recall in the last five years due to a potential contamination of the company's Liquid Probiotic for Infants product with the microorganism pseudomonas aeruginosa. A routine testing led to the discovery of the potential issue and the company decided to carry out a voluntary recall to avoid risk. The source of contamination could be an environmental contamination or the water source as this product was a natural product with no processing treatment as that could damage the probiotic.		
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	70,000 units were included in the recall which is	s 1.05% of total produc	tion in 2021.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDERS	Pseudomonas aeruginosa is a microorganism found in the environment that, if ingested, can cause infection in immunocompromised individuals or, rarely, in very young infants. No illnesses were reported. The FDA classified it as a Class 1 recall.		
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	All potentially affected lots were recalled and destroyed. In addition, the co-manufacturer of the product was disqualified. All finished products are routinely tested as part of the company's independent testing program and new co-manufacturers undergo a rigorous qualification process.
