What does ESG mean?

ESG – short for Environmental, Social and Governance – is a set of standards measuring a business's impact on society, the environment, and how transparent and accountable it is. Here's a more detailed breakdown:

Environmental

The environmental aspect focuses on how the business minimises its impact on the environment. It covers the business's products/services, the supply chain and operations. This considers the company's full impact on the environment, including its carbon footprint, waste management, resource consumption, pollution so it can then implement more sustainable, ethical practices.

Social

The social aspect focuses on how a business impacts wider society and workplace culture. Organisations can positively contribute to fairness & making a difference in society, investing in fair and equal opportunities and conditions for employees, people working in the supply chain, and make a difference in their local communities and society that could include things such as charity partnerships and volunteering.

Governance

Governance refers to the processes of decision-making, reporting, and the logistics of running a business. It also looks at the business's ethical behaviour and its transparency with stakeholders about its activities. All linked to the environmental and social aspects of ESG in that it looks at the transparency and decision-making behind them & policies, processes or certification they have in place to monitor their governance.

We started our journey to lowering our Carbon emissions in 2022 with Greenly who partnered with us to create our first GHG report for 2022, we then continued the journey with 2030Hub into 2023. We have a completed report for 2023 and continue to work on lowering our carbon impact. We are posting monthly sustainability videos to keep everyone up to date on our progress which we believe is an industry first.











We were delighted to be nominated and win Sustainable Business of the Year for the second consecutive year in the Liverpool Chamber of Commerce Innovation in Business Awards in October 2024, it was one of our highlights for the year and a testament to our dedication to being a sustainable company and working towards Net Zero.

We announced our Sustainability Pledge at the Good Small Business Awards in 2023, this new and innovative event is the first of its kind to take place in the UK to highlight the most innovative and sustainable SMEs that are committed to 'Progress Not Perfection'. Since then we have made great strides to reduce our carbon emissions, we have installed 290 solar panels on our roof at Wild Thang which results in us producing more electricity than we need, therefore contributing more green energy back to the grid.

In 2024 with the support of 2030 HUB, we have now surveyed all our supply chain and our clients so we can encourage those partners to make more sustainable decisions for the long term and help us on our journey towards Carbon Net Zero. We have already partnered with Ecologi who are a groundbreaking organisation helping companies, individuals and organisations to fund climate projects to help offset their carbon impact. 


WILD THANG IMPACT VISUALISED
