Summary of Issue	Kompas Kommunikation is a communications agency delivering communication and PR strategy and activities to several pharmaceutical companies in Denmark, the Nordic region and Globally. The company does corporate branding, product marketing, strategic communications advising and product PR.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In FY2023 clients in the pharmaceutical industry represented 80% of the company's revenue.
Impact on Stakeholder(s)	Although the company may not be directly involved in the controversial industry, they have the potential for increasing the negative impact of the controversial industry by serving their clients. As a communications company, the main purpose of their work is to inform patients and healthcare professionals about disease areas, however, their work can lead to an increase in product sales.
Implemented Management Practices	The company follows their branch associations ethical codex on bribery, anti-corruption, lobbying and advocacy activities. In addition, the employees are trained and certified in each of their clients' ethical rules and codex. They also sign due diligence contracts with each client for every new project. To ensure compliance, the company undergoes audits by their clients and has an anonymous whistleblower process in place. As of the finalization of this disclosure the company has passed all audits with no remarks.
