Agripreneurs are enterprising youth from rural villages. Kuza mentors guide them in discovering their interests, talents, aspirations and business opportunities.

Agripreneurs act as trusted advisors to smallholder farmers by offering bundled services of farm advisory, quality inputs, credit and market linkages. They sustain with the commissions from the sale of quality and affordable goods & services.

Agripreneurs engage farmers using innovative portable digital kits with bite-sized HD videos on good agronomy practices in local languages, dramatically reducing the up skilling and networking costs, making them accessible even in off-grid areas.



OneNetwork, a curated digital marketplace, creates accountable relations between value chain actors & Agripreneurs reducing search cost, driving traceability and transparency.


