| Resolution | None of these litigation cases resulted in a verdict against the company and were instead settled out of court. BancoEstado Microempresas S.A., has never had enforceable judgments against it for the violation of fundamental rights of its workers, nor any fines for such reasons. |
| Management Practices | At a preventive level, within the framework of the Leadership program, tools are delivered to the leadership and follow ups are made, to support their management of the workers. |
| | On the other hand, workers with low performance are provided a work plan and support that allows them the opportunity to reverse the results, and avoid termination. |
| | When, despite having made all the previous instances, a termination request is received from managers, the company reviews all the employment records to assess the termination, and it goes through an approval process internally. |
| | In January 2023, the Disengagement procedure was updated and all Banco Estado Microempresas Leaders were trained on this; The objective of these measures was to standardize the separation process throughout the organization, always based on having objective and demonstrable antecedents to decide this, always considering ensuring the working conditions of all workers.) and guarantee that all processes, including this one, are carried out by current regulations, respecting the |
