Disclosure Questionnaire Statement

Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Industries at risk for human rights violations

Topic	Company sources gold and silver
Summary of Issue	Design Letters is a Denmark-based company that designs and sells jewelry made of gold and silver. The company does not source nor use diamonds. The company's mission is to design durable products. The company does not directly work with any mining company.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In 2021, the company's turnover from jewelry items was around 12% of the total turnover.
Impact on Stakeholders	The use of precious metals and gemstones poses a human rights risk due to the possibility that they are sourced from conflict-affected and high-risk areas, where they may be used to finance conflict and/or be associated with human rights abuses in the supply chain.
	B Lab has flagged the jewelry industry as a material issue and new standards will be created to address possible risks related to this matter. Should the Standards Advisory Council determine specific performance requirements for companies in this industry, Design Letters would be required to meet these standards by a future recertification date.
Implemented Management Practices	The company reported the following practices to manage the jewelry industry risks flagged:
	 (1) More about the company's products - All recycled 925 Sterling Silver and 14K gold items are made from silver or gold that has been previously refined and comes from post-consumer products (e.g. existing jewelry, gold/silver bearing products, scrap and waste metals). The company buys recycled materials that are certified by the Responsible Jewelry Council (RJC) or SCS Global Services, - No metal from newly mined gold or silver is used as the base material of the company's jewelry items, - Furthermore, Design Letters has made a commitment that by the end of 2023, will not buy any silver or gold items from raw material that does not have a certification, such as RJC, SCS, or similar.



	 (2) Suppliers policies and practices Since 2021, the company has increased the amount of materials sourced from a supplier which the control of raw materials and production is thorough. This supplier has sufficient certification of the raw materials and the factory procedures (Sedex and RJC), The company has written confirmation from all its suppliers that the raw materials and factories are all "conflict-free" and that forced labor and child labor are not utilized at any point in the supply chain. This is a requirement of the Design Letter's Code of Conduct that all suppliers have to sign. The Code of Conduct and supplier manual apply to Design Letters' first-tier suppliers. Suppliers shall ensure that their first-tier suppliers have adequate processes in place to manage their adverse impacts on human rights including labor rights, environmental, and anti-corruption principles, All suppliers and factories are visited and evaluated regularly.
