Disclosure Materials

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

B Lab's Public Complaints Process

Any party may submit a complaint about a current B Corp through B Lab's Public Complaint Process. Grounds for complaint include:

- Intentional misrepresentation of practices, policies, and/or claimed outcomes during the company's certification process
- 2) Breaches of the B Corp Community's core values as expressed in our Declaration of Interdependence

Summary of Issue	Cariloop, Inc. has clients in the following industries: Offensive Firearms/Weapons/Defense and Pharmaceuticals.
	The company provides employees of clients access to a caregiving support solution. Designed to support the needs of diverse, multi-generational workforces, the company's digital platform offers personalized guidance from expert Care Coaches, premier digital tools, and access to an integrated caregiver support network and community.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the last fiscal year, 9% of the company's annual revenue was from clients in the Offensive Firearms/Weapons/Defense industry and 4% from the pharmaceutical industry.
Impact on Stakeholders	Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can directly or indirectly increase the harmful impact to stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry.
	Companies offering certain types of services and products to controversial clients are required to have at a minimum a grievance/complaints mechanism and a whistleblower protection policy.
Implemented Management Practices	Cariloop, Inc. has the following mechanisms in place to manage the risks related to its business relationships with clients in controversial and ineligible industries:
	Grievance/complaints mechanism. This is accessible to the public through the company's website under the "Confidential Reporting" section. The company provides concerned individuals to raise any grievances anonymously via the Confidential Reporting Form or directly to the Legal Team by email (legal@cariloop.com).



The company would accept and investigate any grievances/concerns raised by stakeholders related to potential violations of company policies, the company's Code of Ethics, or legal and regulatory requirements.

which includes a claim of unfair treatment, discrimination, harassment, or unsafe conditions.

The company would acknowledge receipt of the grievance and provide an initial response regarding the next steps within 5 business days. A preliminary assessment of the complaint received will be done within 10 business days, and if an investigation is required upon the assessment, the company aims to complete it within 30 business days. The company aims to reach a resolution through identifying corrective actions, disciplinary measures, or identifying remedial steps within 15 business days of the completion of the investigation, and would communicate the outcome (when legally and practically possible) to the complainant within 5 business days of the resolution.

Whistleblower Protection. The company has policies that include the following statements:

- Cariloop strictly prohibits retaliation against any individual who reports a concern or participates in an investigation. Any form of retaliation will be addressed promptly and may result in appropriate corrective actions, which may include disciplinary action, additional training, or other remedial actions.
- Cariloop is committed to protecting the confidentiality of the reporting individual to the fullest extent possible, except where disclosure is required by law or necessary to conduct a thorough investigation. Confidentiality will be maintained according to Cariloop Confidentiality Policies. Responsibility for ensuring confidentiality rests with the Legal Team.
