

DISCLOSURE MATERIALS

Certified B Corporations must complete a Disclosure Questionnaire to identify potentially sensitive issues related to the company (e.g. historical fines, sanctions, material litigation, or sensitive industry practices).

This component does not affect the company's score on the B Impact Assessment. If the company answers affirmatively to any items in the Disclosure Questionnaire and B Lab deems them to be material, the company must:

- 1) Be transparent about the disclosure issues identified on the company's public B Impact Report
- 2) Describe how the company has addressed this issue.
- 3) Demonstrate that management systems are in place to avoid similar issues from arising in the future.

In all cases, the Standards Advisory council reserves the right to refuse certification if the company is ultimately deemed not to uphold the spirit of the community.

In addition to the voluntary indication of sensitive issues in the Disclosure Questionnaire, companies pursuing Certification also are subject to background checks by B Lab staff. Background checks include a review of public records, news sources, and search engines for company names, brands, executives/founders, and other relevant topics.

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

TOPIC	On-Site Fatality
SUMMARY OF ISSUE	One of AD&D Partners' employees, a passenger in the delivery driver's truck, was killed in a car accident when another driver ran a stop sign and pushed AD&D's truck into on-coming traffic. This fatality occurred off-site from AD&D Partners' headquarters. The employee-driver had a spotless driving record and the collision was ruled by investigators as not caused by any fault on the part of AD&D Partners' driver.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	This vehicular accident occurred one time in AD&D Partners' operating history and involved one fatality.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDER(S)	The accident resulted in loss of life and injury for the passenger and driver of the vehicle. Following the accident, AD&D's team, particularly its drivers, experienced grief around losing a colleague in such an unexpected manner.
RESOLUTION	Compensation was handled through Workers Comp insurance. AD&D Partners' matched funds raised by staff for deceased's family. AD&D added grief counseling services through its EAP program, which is available to all employees. In order to help minimize risks of future accidents from occurring, AD&D Partners' drivers now participate in defensive driving and safe driving classes. AD&D now purchases life insurance policies for all of its employees at no-cost to the employees.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	Continuation of safe driving training; purchased life insurance on behalf of every employee.

SUMMARY OF ISSUE	Prior to AD&D Partners LLC's forming of Thrift Land Acquisition LLC, the company Thrift Land USA of Yonkers, Inc. was subject to a lawsuit brought by the Attorney General of NY for advertising which caused confusion over the company's charitable status. The company was not a charitable organization, but it used logos from charitable partners to solicit donations, and then sold the donations for a profit.
SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	This incident occurred prior to AD&D Partners LLC's formation of Thrift Land Acquisition LLC or its ownership of any assets of Thrift Land USA of Yonkers Inc.
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDER(S)	N/A
RESOLUTION	In 2015, Thrift Land USA of Yonkers Inc. paid \$700,000 as a result of the case - \$50,000 in penalties and a payment of \$650,000 to two not-for-profit organizations to fulfill the charitable intent of the customers' donations. In 2016, AD&D Partners LLC bought some of the assets of Thrift Land USA of Yonkers Inc. and Thrift Land USA of Yonkers Inc. ceased doing business. AD&D Partners LLC complies with the following mandates, which were the result of Thrift Land of Yonkers Inc's settlement: the company must clearly disclose the for-profit nature of its donation bins, including the company's name and telephone number. It must obtain written signature from the property owners on which the clothing bins sit and it must comply with all applicable zoning and or permitting requirements, including state, local and municipality requirements.
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	This incident occurred prior to AD&D Partners LLC's formation of Thrift Land Acquisition LLC or its ownership of any assets of Thrift Land USA of Yonkers Inc.
