| Summary of Issue | Naïve is a jewelry manufacturing company that makes their jewelry from 100% laboratory produced diamonds and recycled gold. |
| Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected) | 100% of the company's revenue comes from the sale of jewelry. Approximately 60% of the company's Cost of Goods Sold include recycled gold and 30% from laboratory grown diamonds. |
| Impact on Stakeholders | The use of precious metals and gemstones poses a human rights risk due to the possibility that they are sourced from conflict-affected and high risk areas, where they may be used to finance conflict and/or be associated with human rights abuses in the supply chain. |
| Management Practices | The company's diamond supplier provides only lab grown diamonds and uses 60% renewable energy in their production. The company's colored gemstone supplier is accredited as an ethical member of the International Colored Gemstone Association (ICA). |
| | In relation to the gold raw materials purchased, Naïve created the NAIVE GOLD UP program (see link below) involving the collection of waste metals from scrap jewelry which are then sent to professionals who specialize in gold purification, extract pure gold and use this as a raw material to make Naïve jewelry. By using recycled gold, the company ensures that they are not purchasing from first mining operations, or from contexts that could pose a risk of situations involving foced or child labor. |
| | The company does not have any certifications that have social/environmental certifications related to their procurement of precious metals, diamonds, and/or precious stones but indicate to require invoices in all commercial transactions with their suppliers with detailed and faithful specifications on their invoice in relation of the product or service that was transacted. The company requires from the sellers of antique jewelry such documentation to prove their identity (CPF and RG Brazilian identity registry, as well as proof of address). |



| | Naive has a Supplier Code of Conduct that includes: - Zero tolerance to Child and Forced Labor and compliance with the conventions of the International Labor Organization (ILO) - The requirement of fair working hours and wages in accordance with local laws and industry standards - A healthy working environment - The respect and protection of human rights of their employees and local communities, avoiding any form of discrimination and abuse. - Natural Resource management to protect the environment - The implementation of procedures to reduce emissions, prevent environmental contamination and manage waste responsibly. - The protection of biodiversity in conducting their activities.
