Topic	Labor issues
Summary of Issue	Sabará Ingredientes e Quimicos had 7 litigation cases related to labor issues in the past 5 years. The cases are related to the following topics: • Claims related to illness resulted from an unhealthy work environment. • Overtime and other additional unpaid wages; • Additional payments are related to the nature of the job. In addition to that, the company is also cited in 11 other labor cases of its suppliers as a subsidiary responsibility of the second or third degree.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Sabará Ingredientes e Quimicos had 5 cases pending and 2 settled with payment, summing up R\$ 2,708,967. The company has only one case settled with payment related to the subsidiary responsibility cases. The company has paid approximately R\$ 75,000 in said case.
Impact on Stakeholders	There were financial and health impacts on the employees.
Resolution	Two cases had a verdict against the company and five cases are pending or waiting for appeal. Seven cases of subsidiary responsibility were settled without any payments from the company. One case was settled with payment, and three are pending resolution.
Management Practices	Review the position with the HR department to avoid recurrence. The company also works with suppliers to provide orientation on this matter.

Summary of Issue	Sabará Químicos e Ingredientes has clients in the following industry: Pharmaceuticals.
	The types of products and services offered to these clients include: • Solutions to help with the development of pharmaceutical products, • Ingredients such as grade oils that are specifically designed to be used in pharmaceutical products.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the last fiscal year, 0.24% of the company's annual revenue was from clients in the pharmaceutical industry.
Impact on Stakeholders	Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can directly or indirectly increase the harmful impact on stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry.
	Companies offering certain types of services and products to controversial clients are required to have at a minimum a grievance/complaints mechanism and a whistleblower protection policy.
Implemented Management Practices	Sabará has the following mechanisms in place to manage the risks associated with serving clients in the mining industry:
	Grivance/complaints mechanism. This is accessible to the public through the company's website. Complaints about misconduct or violations of the Compliance Manual guidelines can also be sent confidentially by e-mail to etica@gruposabara.com or through a corporate website page.
	On the Sustainability Report, the company includes the Sabará Group Compliance Manual, where there is a section on "Mechanisms for reporting and investigating irregularities"



starting on page 65. The reporting mechanisms and how the company and the compliance committee should deal with complaints received is provided within the manual. All of the company's business partners receive the manual together with their contract, in addition to all employees receiving it upon orientation. The company is open to receiving any type of complaint/report against its employees and other business partners on any behaviour/action that violates the Compliance Manual, which aims to ensure respect for human beings and the environment, and to act in a transparent, efficient manner and in accordance with applicable legislation. The company would respond to the complaint received within 24 hours from the time the complaint was reported. Whistleblower Protection. The Sabará Group Compliance Manual includes the following statements: The whistleblower's communication channel was created to protect the identity of any individuals reporting an incident/raising a concern. • The Compliance Committee has the responsibility to carry out internal and confidential processing of cases that come to its attention, seeking to listen to those involved and provide them with equal and non-discriminatory treatment In addition to the confidentiality guaranteed, no punitive action will be taken against the whistleblower for this act itself.
