Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Other - Clients in Controversial Industries

Торіс	Clients in Controversial Industries
Summary of Issue	Deminor Recovery Services provides litigation funding services, allowing a claimant to pursue claims through litigation or arbitration. The company pays all legal costs and does not receive any remuneration or return unless the case is successful, and the claimant achieves a recovery. In the event of a recovery, the company receives a share of the proceeds. If the case is unsuccessful, the funder loses its money, and nothing is owed by the claimant. Subject to regulatory restrictions in certain jurisdictions, Deminor as funder may also offer litigation management & support services in conjunction with litigation funding.
	The company has provided its funding for clients in the Alcohol, Fossil-Fuel (including coal/oil sands), Mining, and Pharmaceutical industries, which are deemed controversial by B Lab.
	The same services provided to the clients can be sold to clients in different industries, including other non-controversial and controversial industries.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The company has yet to earn any revenue from the clients deemed controversial as of October 2024, as all of the cases are ongoing and have yet to reach a resolution. Deminor would not earn any revenue from a client until a litigation is closed in favor of its client.
	The company's capital invested in each of the controversial industries for the year of 2024 are; • 0.9% for its client in the alcohol industry • 0.1% for its client in the fossil-fuel industry • 3.2% for its clients in the mining industry • 5.4% for its clients in the pharmaceutical industry
Impact on Stakeholders	Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can indirectly increase the harmful impact on stakeholders by



	enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry.
	B Lab has flagged the involvement of companies with clients in controversial industries as a material issue, and new standards will be created to address possible risks related to this matter.
Implemented Management Practices	Deminor currently does not have a formal position on working with particular sensitive industries or a policy to move away from them. The services provided by the company enable clients to seek justice through a litigation claim, regardless of the industry. The company has a due diligence and compliance process, which includes "Know Your Customer" (KYC) activities and conflict checks on potential clients. The processes ensure that
	the clients meet Deminor's ethical requirements and values.



Disclosure Questionnaire Statement

Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Litigation, Arbitration, Penalties, and/or Regulatory

Deminor Recovery Services (Luxembourg) SA reported having two material litigations filed against the company related to the following issues: contract dispute. Those cases had repercussions in the last five years.

Legal disputes, arbitration, penalties, and regulatory complaints can adversely affect external stakeholders by disrupting customer service, causing uncertainty and negative financial impacts for suppliers and employees, and diminishing investor confidence. Additionally, these issues may damage the company's reputation and result in broader economic and regulatory repercussions. Certified B Corps must make their involvement in Litigation, Arbitration, Penalties, and Regulatory complaints transparent under their B Corp Profile.
