Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Animal Products and Services

Topic	Company sources and retails animal products
Summary of Issue	SAS Huso is a company based in France that breeds and sells sturgeon meat and its derived products including caviar. The two species of sturgeon that the company breeds are both endangered and on the list of endangered species. The majority of the company's product portfolio is certified Friends of the Sea and is Certified Organic.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	100% of the company's revenue consists of products from the fishing, fisheries, and aquaculture industry. >90% of the company's product portfolio is Certified Friends of the Sea.
Impact on Stakeholders	The fishing industry may have negative environmental impacts on their affected marine ecosystems, e.g., overfishing, loss of biodiversity, pollution. Furthermore, the fishing industry is at risk of human rights violations in their supply chains.
Implemented Management Practices	SAS Huso's breeding system is the open circuit without filtration or treatment of the water at the entrance. The renewal of all their basins is 20 to 50% / hour depending on the age of the fish.
	Friends of the Sea contributes to the development of the sustainable seafood movement by certifying companies that reduce mortality of endangered species, stimulate improvement in fish stocks' management, promote appropriate waste management, and social accountability. The Friend of the Sea standard is recognized by national accreditation bodies and audits are carried out on-site by independent certification bodies.
	In addition to obtaining the Friends of the Sea Certification and being certified Organic, the company follows the AquaRéa (Responsible Aquaculture), addressing matters related to breeding and resource management. The current method to evaluate animal wellbeing is to consider the mortality in breeding, which is currently 1.7% of the biomass for FY22, a rate lower than the average for sturgeon farms in France (3-4%).

Topic	Company has the breeding site located adjacent to Isle River, its banks and the accompanying wetland.
Summary of Issue	The sensitive ecosystem is the Isle river, its banks, and the accompanying wetland. The protections in France are: • The Water Law: protects the river, its banks • The site has classification as a NATURA 2000 zone, which entails specific protection measures (fauna, flora)
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	100% of the company's production occurs in the breeding site that is located in a sensitive ecosystem.
Impact on Stakeholders	The risks of the company's operation on the sensitive ecosystem are: • The release of alien species (Siberian sturgeons and Oscietra) into the river • Restrictions on animal movements and their reproduction • Destruction of the habitat of rare species
Implemented Management Practices	As users of the area, SAS HUSO respects very specific rules and carries out environmental impact studies before any action. The summary of these rules is defined in the ICPE decree (Installation Classified for the Protection of the Environment) To go further, the company wishes to sign a contract with the protection teams of the Natura 2000 area.



Disclosure Questionnaire Category: Alcohol

HUSO SAS is involved in the production or sale of alcohol, which has risks of potential negative impact on the health and well-being of individuals and their communities. Based on the size of the company, these impacts may be limited. Certified B Corps are required to make transparent their involvement in such industries.
