Topic	Environmental Risks in the Supply Chain
	Daléro is a Dutch B2B supplier specializing in composite (glass fiber reinforced plastic, GRP) profiles and gratings, serving markets across Europe. They sell both standard and fully customized products using pultrusion and molding processes to create lightweight, durable, and corrosion-resistant components. The company is not involved in the production process. The suppliers of the Dalero produce the profiles, that are made of glass and polymer.
	These suppliers manufacture the panels using resin and polyester, which are combined to create the final composite material. By the production of polymer (plastics) fossil fuels are used. The resin and glycols used are petroleum-based. The end product consists of approximately 35% resin, 60% glass fiber, and 5% fillers. This composition is similar to materials used by companies producing durable plastic-based products. Unlike many products in sectors like food or cosmetics, the company's materials are not single-use plastics.

r	The use of fossil fuels in the production of resin and polyester releases CO ₂ emissions, which have a negative impact on the environment.
Management Practices	The production process used by the company's suppliers is standard within the industry and complies with all relevant safety regulations. Suppliers have precautionary systems in place—such as fume extraction units—to minimize exposure to emissions during manufacturing. In addition, government authorities regularly inspect these facilities. These production facilities operate under strict safety and environmental protocols. Regular audits and government inspections help ensure compliance with relevant standards. Daléro has proactively developed a self-assessment framework to regularly evaluate and improve the safety and sustainability



of its suppliers' production processes. This helps Dalero identify potential risks early and maintain high standards in its supply chain operations.

Daléro has also implemented a supplier policy that outlines its expectations regarding environmental performance, worker safety, and ethical practices. This policy is shared with all its suppliers and serves as a basis for dialogue, monitoring, and continuous improvement. In addition, the company conducts informal assessments and maintains close contact with its key suppliers to ensure compliance and mutual accountability.
