Issue Date	Ongoing
Topic	Civil, labor and tax lawsuits filed against CENTER NORTE S/A, subsidiary of BAUMGART PARTICIPACOES S/A
Summary of Issue	Labor claims involve a range of actions filed by former employees and third-parties relating, among other things, to overtime, working conditions and compensation. The company also had civil cases related to rental contract agreements with its clients, and tax related penalties.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In the period between 2008 - 2022, BAUMGART PARTICIPACOES S/A's subsidiary CENTER NORTE S/A has had 281 lawsuits. The total amount claimed in said proceedings is approximately BRL 115.8 MM and a projected payout value of BRL 20.1 MM, yielding a 17.5% expected payout rate.
Impact on Stakeholders	The primary impact related to labor litigations is a financial and wellbeing impact on employees and other third-party stakeholders. Regarding civil impacts, the majority is related to rental contracts renewals.
Resolution	(i) Pending cases: 281. The total amount claimed is BRL 115.8 MM, and a projected payout value (provision) of 20.1 MM. (ii) Closed cases: all cases reported above are open and have not yet been resolved.
Implemented Management Practices	BAUMGAR PARTICIPACOES S/A's subsidiary CENTER NORTE S/A has implemented management practices to mitigate the risk of future litigation cases and to tackle and address some of the key causes of litigation.  These include:  1) Restructuring of its departments and teams, aiming at the
	improvement of internal processes, corporate practices and the company's transparency for the market and its stakeholders; 2) Replacement of the old legal department that was outsourced, and the implementation of an internal new legal department in charge of the company's Executive Management. The intention is to conduct the company's legal affairs more aligned with the business strategy; 3) New software to manage the company's lawsuits. 4) Preventive policies to improve the partnerships through



	contractual terms.
Management Comments	In addition,the company had implemented improvements to their processes over the years, such as
	1) implementation the payment of PPR (profit sharing program) based on the GPTW climate survey; 2) change of office to improve their work facilities structure; 3) change of the operational team's working location, since the old location presented a risk of work accidents for employees; 4) quality of life actions among employees (Track 'n' Field races, mental health circles, blood donation, exemption from co-participation for preventive health exams in October and November, among others); 5) expansion of celebration actions.
