Topic	Clients in Controversial Industries
Summary of Issue	Sarona Asset Management manages funds and provides access to finance for clients in the Payday, Short Term, or High Interest Lending and For-profit higher education industry.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In 2022, 2.25% of the company's annual revenue was derived from clients in the Payday, Short Term, or High Interest Lending and > 5% of the company's annual revenue was derived from clients in the For-profit higher education industry.
Impact on Stakeholders	Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can indirectly increase the harmful impact to stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry. B Lab has flagged the involvement of companies with clients in controversial industries as a material issue and new standards
	will be created to address possible risks related to this matter.
Implemented Management Practices	Company has a risk assessment team that conducts due diligence on all clients. Due diligence is done within the company's compliance framework which includes audits and internal controls.

Topic	Investment funds in the Cayman Islands
Summary of Issue	Sarona Asset Management is an investment company operating in the Netherlands, US, Canada, Singapore and Australia. The company advises investment funds registered in the Cayman Islands. These funds fall outside the scope of the B Corp certification.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In Fiscal Year 2022, the effective tax rate for the company was 12.2% for the first C\$500,000 in net income before taxes and 26.5% for the net income before taxes over C\$500,000.
Impact on Stakeholders	Companies in the wealth planning structures industry play a significant role in global wealth holding and creation, alongside other financial service companies, especially those who operate in jurisdictions that are known as tax havens for corporations or individuals. Given the important nature of their services, their operations and business models also have associated risks. While a company's specific risk will vary, the most material potential risks related to the industry can be categorized as: concealment of beneficial ownership and wealth sources; money laundering and corruption; and tax evasion and avoidance.
Implemented Management Practices	Sarona Asset Management pays taxes in all the countries where it has operations. The company issues TAC forms annually and each individual investor is accountable for declaring their capital gains. The company is also fully compliant with FATCA (Foreign Account Tax Compliance Act), CRS (Common Reporting Standards), and global tax transparency agreements.
