Topic	Penalty related to failing to report positive listeria environmental results
Summary of Issue	Over the last 5 years Epicurean Dairy Ltd has had 1 penalty issued by the Ministry of Primary Industries (MPI) related to the company's failing to report positive listeria results in the manufacturing environment during the 2012- 2016 period. No product was affected.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Epicurean Dairy Ltd paid a \$369,000 fine which represented 1.4% of the company revenue during the reported period.  The company's General Manager at the time was fined \$54,000, as well as the former Operations Manager \$60,000. Court costs
	of \$80,000 were also imposed.
Impact on Stakeholders	There were no reported consumer illnesses.
Resolution	The case was closed in 2019 when a fine was issued to Epicurean Dairy Ltd and its managers. Prior to the final fines being issued, the company's former Operations Manager was convicted after pleading guilty earlier that year to 5 charges of deliberately withholding positive environmental listeria results. Epicurean Dairy and the company's former General Manager, also pleaded guilty to a total of 10 charges.
Implemented Management Practices	At the time of the event in 2016, the company's Operations Manager departed the business and a new General Manager was put in place.
	The leadership of manufacturing and quality functions were split into two roles to avoid the conflict of interest. Two new roles were appointed: a Quality and Compliance Manager and a Manufacturing Manager. Having a lead in the Quality team gave focus to adherence to quality standards and compliance of the company's Risk Management Plan.
	The source of the environmental results were on the factory floor which was replaced and there have been no further cases of this kind since.
