Торіс	Penalties related to Traffic Violation
Summary of Issue	Puremilk Co, LTD is a company based in Taiwan that specializes in the sale of milk and dairy products, including yogurt and milk buns.
	Between 2019 and 2023, the company received 309 fines from the Ministry of Transportation for various traffic violations. The details of the violations are as follows: - 33 cases of exceeding the speed limit - 8 cases related to daily regular inspections - 4 cases of failure to use indicator lights in accordance with regulations - 233 cases of illegal parking - 10 cases of late payment penalties - 21 cases of not adhering to road markings All violations have been fully resolved by the company through
	payment of the respective fines.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	All cases have been settled through the payment of fines, which represent the following percentages of the company's revenue: - Speeding violations: 0,0066% - Regular inspection violations: 0,0007% - Failure to use indicator lights: 0,0005% - Illegal parking cases: 0,0173% - Late payment penalties: 0,0003% - Road marking violations: 0,0048%
Impact on Stakeholders	The safety of road users is compromised.
Resolution	All cases have been resolved through the payment of fines.
Implemented Management Practices	When the new traffic regulations came into effect in 2023, the company organized a conference to brief all employees on the updated regulations and to reinforce the importance of adhering to traffic rules. This briefing was documented and communicated to all staff.
	To prevent similar incidents in the future, the company has



	implemented the following measures: - During onboarding, all drivers are required to undergo training to ensure they operate trucks in full compliance with regulations. - In cases where violations occur due to personal misconduct, the driver will be held responsible for paying any associated fines. - Beginning in October 2024, the company will incorporate the number of traffic violations into driver performance evaluations. However, violations arising from the absence of or insufficient legal unloading zones near delivery points will not be counted against the driver's performance.
Report	News Report + New Traffic ordinance protests
Management Comments	The root cause is related to issues with Taiwan's road planning. To meet delivery deadlines, drivers often have to park illegally due to inadequate road planning, insufficient unloading parking spaces, and limited unloading areas. This results in drivers needing to park improperly to handle the high volume of packages. While the new traffic regulations are stricter, there was insufficient discussion with truck drivers before these regulations were drafted.
