


Whilst in our property division we are particularly proud of our focus on working with tenants who are leading the way in eco and environmental projects, including the creation of sustainable energy and high-volume plastic recycling.

Completing our group is our Charitable Trust. It is important to us to give back and it forms a large part of the values we have as individuals and as a business. The organisations and people we help are truly inspirational.

# PROPERTY DEVELOPMENT

We are making progress to make sure all our rented properties reach a minimum EPC of C or above.

One of our current retrofits is a local site where the building was purchased with damaged materials, flooding, single brick and no natural lighting. Plans have commenced to take the building back to its frame and repair with insulation, LED lighting, glazing upgrades and occupancy sensors. Once complete this will achieve EPC grade A.



Many of our rented properties include; EV charging points Solar Panels Battery plant storage



One of our sites is leased to a recycling plant that is capable of recycling 57,000 tonnes of plastic, or 1.3bn plastic bottles, per year.

# **OUR CHARITABLE TRUST**

The purpose of the Kans and Kandy Charitable Trust is to support and promote charitable organisations regardless of location, race, colour, religion or gender.

We will continue to focus on poverty, disability, end of life care, cancer research, homelessness, and education. Our immediate focus will be the support of:

- Tiny Lives Neonatal care.
- Pathways 4 All Parent-led charity, providing play and leisure services for disabled children and young people.
- Heel & Toe Children's Charity that supports children with Cerebral Palsy and other physical disabilities.
- Dragonfly Cancer Trust Working with families, hospitals, and hospices across the UK supporting young people (aged 0-25) with terminal cancer.
- Maggies Cancer Charity Charity that provides free expert care and support in centres across the UK and online
- St Cuthberts Hospice Providing palliative and end of life care services for people living in North Durham, at a time and a place that is right for them.
- The Peoples Kitchen Supporting homeless and vulnerable people and help fight hunger and loneliness for locals in need.
- Woman's Cancer Detection Society The Women's Cancer Detection Society is a local charity based in the breast cancer screening unit at the QE in Gateshead focussing on early detection of breast cancer.
- Escape Intervention working with 4-25 year olds and their parents/carers. It is our goal to help and support as many children, young people and their families to overcome any barriers to personal success through using a holistic approach to treat the whole person, taking into account all factors that contribute to their problems.
- Northumbria University Education without barriers 15 scholarships commencing 2024 for 3 years.
- Kids Out Gives disadvantaged children positive experiences to support them becoming future members of our society.
- Smart Works UK charity that exists to give women the confidence they need to reach their full potential, secure employment, and change the trajectory of their lives.

# **WHAT'S NEXT**

Over the course of the next year, our goals include:

#### **Workers:**

- Continue to promote healthy work-life balance.
- Review and offer training programmes to our staff for courses suitable to their role including Forklift courses more frequently than recommended of 3 years.
- Continue to enforce breaks during long periods of using a screen and encourage walks at lunchtime.
- Arrange a yearly away day for all staff to enjoy and support their mental health.

### **Environment:**

- Continue to improve our recycling process and use more recycled products within our supplier chain.
- Improve at least one property we purchase through KKP from an EPC of C or below to A/B a year.

### **Governance:**

- Encourage participation from staff and promote diversity in the workplace to strengthen our success.
- To enrol all staff who work within an office based role onto a cyber security training programme.

# **Community:**

- Support a local football team as a sponsor or donation to help with equipment.
- Offer all staff to participate in a charitable event with support from our trust and encourage independent fund raising.
- Agree a donation of £2,500 to a charity chosen by each key personnel to donate throughout the year.
- For each charity that we donate over £10,000 a year, we must have a targeted report of how the donation has been used to good use.

- Continue to use eco-friendly logistic partners.
- Reduce emissions from business related travel.
