

DISCLOSURE MATERIALS

Certified B Corporations must complete a Disclosure Questionnaire to identify potentially sensitive issues related to the company (e.g. historical fines, sanctions, material litigation, or sensitive industry practices).

This component does not affect the company's score on the B Impact Assessment. If the company answers affirmatively to any items in the Disclosure Questionnaire and B Lab deems them to be material, the company must:

- 1) Be transparent about the disclosure issues identified on the company's public B Impact Report
- 2) Describe how the company has addressed this issue.
- 3) Demonstrate that management systems are in place to avoid similar issues from arising in the future.

In all cases, the Standards Advisory council reserves the right to refuse certification if the company is ultimately deemed not to uphold the spirit of the community.

In addition to the voluntary indication of sensitive issues in the Disclosure Questionnaire, companies pursuing Certification also are subject to background checks by B Lab staff. Background checks include a review of public records, news sources, and search engines for company names, brands, executives/founders, and other relevant topics.

Sensitive issues identified through background checks may or may not be within the scope of questions in the Disclosure Questionnaire, but undergo the same review process and are subject to the same possible review by the Standards Advisory Council, including ineligibility for B Corp Certification, required remediation, or disclosure.

SIZE/SCOPE OF ISSUE (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	Company earns 100% of its revenue from the sale of honey and wax products which is sourced from the forests in Tanzania. They work with 1,600 registered beekeepers.		
IMPACT ON STAKEHOLDER(S)	The company has policies and practices in place to ensure and promote the sustainable harvesting of honey by their beekeeper suppliers. They have also implemented practices to reduce the harmful impacts to local biodiversity. The beekeepers promote the conservation of the local forest in which they operate by promoting a stable economy around honey.		
IMPLEMENTED MGT PRACTICES	As part of the company's organic internal standards, beekeepers are not permitted to harvest brood comb. Brood comb is honey in which baby bees are currently maturing. It is critical to colony survival. In addition, they require beekeepers to agree to no illegal hunting while they are in the forests harvesting honey.
