Topic	Clients in Controversial Industries
Summary of Issue	Round is a strategy consulting and investment company operating in Denmark that has had clients operating in the Zoos, Jewellery and Pharmaceuticals industries over the last 5 years. The nature of the company's services with clients in these industries has been related to tracking and executing strategies; all services can be sold to both controversial as well as non-controversial industries.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	The revenue from clients in the Pharmaceuticals industry represented 12% in FY23-24. The revenue from clients in the Zoo industry represented 0% in FY23-24. The revenue from clients in the Jewellery industry represented 11% in FY23-24.
Impact on Stakeholders	Companies that work with clients in controversial industries can indirectly increase the harmful impact to stakeholders by enabling business growth. Therefore, companies that work with clients in these industries should have practices in place to ensure that their impact is aimed at decreasing the negative impacts of the industry. B Lab has flagged the involvement of companies with clients in controversial industries as a material issue and new standards will be created to address possible risks related to this matter.
Implemented Management Practices	Round prioritize working with clients in sensitive industries if the project's objective offers a substantial opportunity to enhance the client's contribution to society, particularly in terms of Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) metrics referenced below. When evaluating new opportunities, projects are evaluated on based on ESG criteria, from both a baseline and future view. ESG Metrics – Environment • Resource use Does the company / will the project help the company to reduce the use of materials, energy or water, and to find more eco-efficient solutions by improving supply chain management?



- Emissions | Does the company / will the project help the company to reduce environmental emissions in its production and operational processes?
- Innovation | Does the company / will the project help the company to reduce the environmental costs and burdens for its customers, thereby creating new market opportunities through new environmental technologies and processes, or eco-designed products?
