Topic	Energy and Emissions Intensive Industries
Summary of Issue	As a food manufacturer, Verstegen Spices & Sauces B.V. operates in an energy-intensive industry.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	100% of Verstegen Spices & Sauces B.V.2022 revenue generated from sales of herbs & spices.  68% of the company's energy consumption in 2022 is from renewable energy where 65.95% is on-site solar generation and the remaining 1.64% is from the purchased wind power energy.  The company's carbon emission in 2022 was 3,243.08 tCO2e, and offset 100% of its emission by purchasing a total of 3445 tCO2e carbon credits.
Impact on Stakeholders	Energy intensive manufacturing activities pose an environmental risk due to the emissions produced by such energy use. The extent of environmental impact is dependent on the energy sources utilised and management practices in place to manage energy use.
Implemented Management Practices	Verstegen Spices & Sauces B.V has set a scientific-based target to reduce 50% of its emissions in 2030 as compared to 2018 and eventually to be net zero by 2050. The company has planned to achieve the target by:  - Install more solar panel and aim to generate 100% of renewable energy  - A scheme to change the company's vehicles to electrical vehicles.  - Replacing natural gas usage with electricity that is powered by renewable energy.

Summary of Issue	As a food manufacturer, Verstegen Spices & Sauces B.V. operates in an energy-intensive industry.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	100% of Verstegen Spices & Sauces B.V.2023 revenue generated from sales of herbs & spices. The main source of water is from the tap water. Verstegen Spices & Sauces B.V uses water in production mainly for the cleaning process and water acts as an ingredient in some sauces. However, the usage of water as ingredients is negligible as most of the products (Sauces) are oil-based.
Impact on Stakeholders	As a water intensive industry, the manufacturing industry poses risks such as water stress or depletion of local water sources if water use is not appropriately managed.
Implemented Management Practices	Verstegen Spices & Sauces B.V. has taken measures to reduce water consumption in their facilities. One initiative includes the installation of waterless urinals in the toilets, effectively minimizing water usage. Additionally, an innovative rainwater collection system has been implemented in the office building, specifically designed to supply water for sanitary facilities.  Moreover, Verstegen Spices & Sauces B.V. has implemented an on-site wastewater treatment plant to manage the water used for cleaning purposes during production. This treatment plant ensures that the water is appropriately treated before being discharged into the sewerage system. These initiatives demonstrate Verstegen's commitment to sustainable water management practices.
