Summary of Issue	data.world provides a data catalog through a software as a service and has had one client over the past 5 years in the fossil fuel industry. The company's product is not targeted to the fossil fuel industry but can be used by any organization that handles data. data.world's Software as a Service helps customers agree on a glossary of common terms, identify data sources and manage their data as well as help them comply with legislation.
Size/Scope of Issue (e.g. \$ financial implication, # of individuals affected)	In 2022, 1.34% of the company's revenue was represented by serving clients in the controversial industry.
Impact on Stakeholders	While products and services to clients in controversial industries could help mitigate potential negative impacts or serve only as commonplace goods and services for the companies, they also could have the potential to enable the growth of the industry and indirectly contribute to its negative impacts. Certified B Corps are required to make transparent their involvement in such industries. B Lab has flagged the involvement of companies with clients in controversial industries as a material issue and new standards will be created to address possible risks related to this matter.
Management Practices	data.world has a Code of Conduct on its website and expects its vendors and customers to abide by it. The company does not currently carry out a separate due diligence on its customers. Although the company does not have a written position on working with clients in controversial industries, they take into consideration their mission as a public benefit corporation and B Corp Certification in mind while evaluating prospects.

	The company states that their services guide clients to understand their data, which in turn leads clients to better understand compliance and reporting and makes them more accurate in these endeavors.
