SUMMARY OF ISSUE	Gaia Herbs is located adjacent to Paisgah National Forest, which lies in parts of 12 counties in western North Carolina: Transylvania, McDowell, Haywood, Madison, Caldwell, Burke, Yancey, Buncombe, Avery, Mitchell, Henderson, and Watauga counties. This forest is classified as a Targeted Local Watershed (TLW). These areas are chosen based on an evaluation of three factors—problems, assets, and opportunities. Problems reflect the need for restoration, assets reflect the ability for a watershed to recover from degradation and the need for land conservation, and opportunity indicates the potential for local partnerships in restoration and conservation work.
