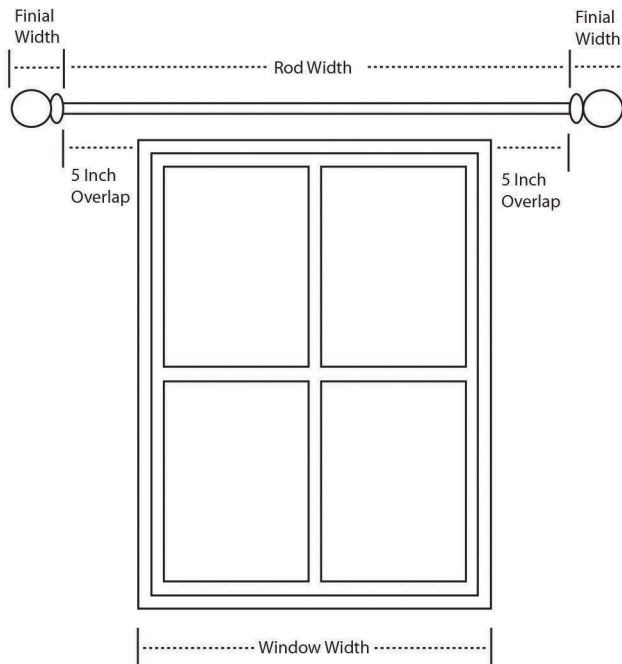


MEASURING GUIDE



Determine Your Hardware Width

Rod width does not include the width of the finials on each end. Finials add 2" to 11" in width on each end, depending on the finial style. We recommend a 5" overlap on each side of the window. For example if your window is 50" wide, you would normally order a 60" length rod and the overall finished width would be 64" to 84" depending upon the finial style.



Measuring Tips

- Always use a steel tape measure. All dimensions should be taken to the nearest 1/4 inch.
- Double check to make sure that you haven't transposed width and height measurements.
- Measure every window. Windows that look identical often are not.
