Ponce notes: "While most Cali Pinots are long on fruit and short on character, this cheapie is a pleasant surprise. It offers a floral nose, juicy acidity, and beguilingly bitter, beet-laced finish."

### Coyote's Run Red Paw Vineyard Pinot Noir 2011, \$22.95

From Niagara-on-the-Lake, this bottle is named after the vineyard's red, iron-rich loam. Try with grilled salmon.

Ponce notes: "A bouquet of sour cherry and smouldering campfire sets the nose a-twitching. It's a light, earthy red with a grinding of pepper over the fruit and great balance—an ace Pinot."

### Maison Roche de Bellene Savigny-Les-Beaune Vieilles Vignes 2010, \$22.95

Made by Burgundy négociant Nicolas Potel, this wine comes from a vineyard that was planted in 1947. Open with roast chicken.

Ponce notes: "It's about as light as red wine gets, with tart-berry flavours and an undercurrent of forest floor. Chill lightly and enjoy a glass after raking the leaves."
