Sep. 11, 2013: **EVANGELOS TSANTALIS** Athiri Macedonia 2011 (85 points, \$10)

Tropical fruit, herbal and grassy flavors fill this crisp, rustic white, with chalk and lemon-lime notes that extend on the spicy finish. Drink now. 17,000 cases made. —*Kim Marcus*

Sep. 10, 2013: **LOUIS BERNARD** Lubéron 2010 (87 points, \$12)

Big and beefy for a Lubéron, featuring dark plum skin, blackberry preserves and roasted tobacco leaf notes, framed by a charcoal edge on the finish. Drink now. 8,000 cases made. —*James Molesworth*

Sep. 09, 2013: **ISAAC FERNANDEZ SELECCIÓN** Brut Rosé Cava Biutiful NV (85 points, \$14)

Dry and tangy, with a base of candied black cherry, showing hints of ripe plum, ground spice and strawberries and cream. Drink now. 5,000 cases made. —*Alison Napjus*

Sep. 07, 2013: **FRANCIS FORD COPPOLA** Pinot Noir California Votre Santé 2011 (86 points, \$14)

Light and elegant, with cedar and clove aromatics mingling with candied cherry and strawberry fruit notes. Smooth. Drink now through 2018. 21,141 cases made. —*MaryAnn Worobiec*

Sep. 06, 2013: **BARNARD GRIFFIN** Chardonnay Columbia Valley 2011 (89 points, \$14)

A strong floral streak runs through pear and grapefruit flavors on a light, lime-tinged chassis. Shows refinement. Drink now through 2016. 18,000 cases made. —*Harvey Steiman*
