[Bourgogne Pinot Black Boisset Les Ursulines 2014](#) - Good burgundy red entry, well-typed, rather finely wooded (10 percent new oak), a slightly herbaceous character but also a floral side. Freshness and greed!



[Jean-Claude Boisset Bourgogne Aligoté Bio 2014](#) - An impeccable white grape, with tasty smoked accents, alertness, maybe even a little volatile acidity that adds freshness. Subtle woody component (15 percent new oak) which contributes to the complexity. At \$ 25.55, a very good value!



[Bonpas Grande Réserve Des Challières Ventoux 2015](#) - At a low price (\$ 13 and dust), a very good red from the Rhône valley, fruity and spicy, with no residual sugar and acidity well endowed with. Freshness is the rendezvous is to say, as well as the generosity.
