### **Vinicultural Society & Winegrowing Dinner at Buena Vista Winery**

One of **my favorite wineries** to visit in Sonoma Valley is Buena Vista, and they are launching a new series of Vinicultural Society dinners – launching with their first one on Friday.

This dinner will take place deep in the heart of the Champagne Caves – deep within the Mayacamas Mountains that between Sonoma and Napa.

Dinner is hosted by Count Agoston Harazthy and Director of Winegrowing Eric Pooler, who will share the details about the 19th century winegrowing methods that the Count brought to America and how they are being used at Buena Vista today.

The multi-course meal is prepared by Jean-Charles Boisset's personal chef, Chef Michel Cornu. Food will be paired with Buena Vista wine, including a few surprises.
